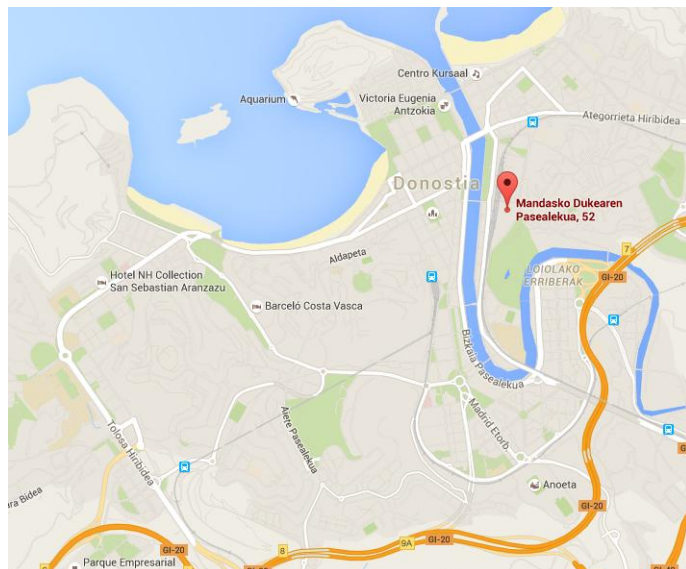

THE CITY

San Sebastián, with a population of 186,000, stands as an amphitheatre overlooking the sea. It is known the world over for its spectacular bay and is referred to as “the Pearl of the Cantabrian Sea.” The unparalleled beauty, cosmopolitan atmosphere, and high standards offered to everyone who comes to visit San Sebastián have turned the city into a world-class conference and meeting destination.

The city enjoys a privileged location in Europe. Only 20 km from the border with France and less than 100 km from the other capital cities of the Basque Country, San Sebastián makes an ideal base to visit legendary places as the beautiful, aristocratic town of Biarritz, or the famed Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao.

San Sebastián is small enough to be pleasantly negotiated on foot or by bike, so business travellers will enjoy walking or cycling around to make the most of their trip. The city boasts a wide range of pedestrian areas, parks, landscaped gardens, and wonderful walks along the sea and the river, which makes it really easy to get around on foot or by bike to visit the city’s sights.

HOW TO ARRIVE

San Sebastián is a city that can be easily accessed by any means of transport, as it boasts a modern and expanding road network, a national and international railway system connected to Europe via the French TGV, and an airport of its own. Moreover, the city is less than an hour’s drive to the other two international airports in the area: Bilbao and Biarritz.
