Conveniently located just a few minutes from the M25, M3 and M4 and just seven miles from London Heathrow Airport.

The College is on the A30, 19 miles from central London and about a mile south-west of the town of Egham. It is two miles from Junction 13 of the M25 (London Orbital).

Directions from the M25

- After leaving the M25, follow the A30 west (signposted Bagshot and Camberley); this is the Egham bypass.
- At the end of the Egham bypass, continue on the A30 up Egham Hill (a petrol station is on your left).
- The main College entrance is on the left immediately after the second footbridge.

Directions from the West:

- Leave the M3 at junction 3, at the roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A322.
- Proceed under the bridge and turn left, then merge onto the A30.
- At the roundabout, take the second exit onto the A30.

- Continue on the A30, through Sunningdale towards Staines-upon-Thames
- The main College entrance is on the right immediately before the footbridge

By Taxi from the Airport

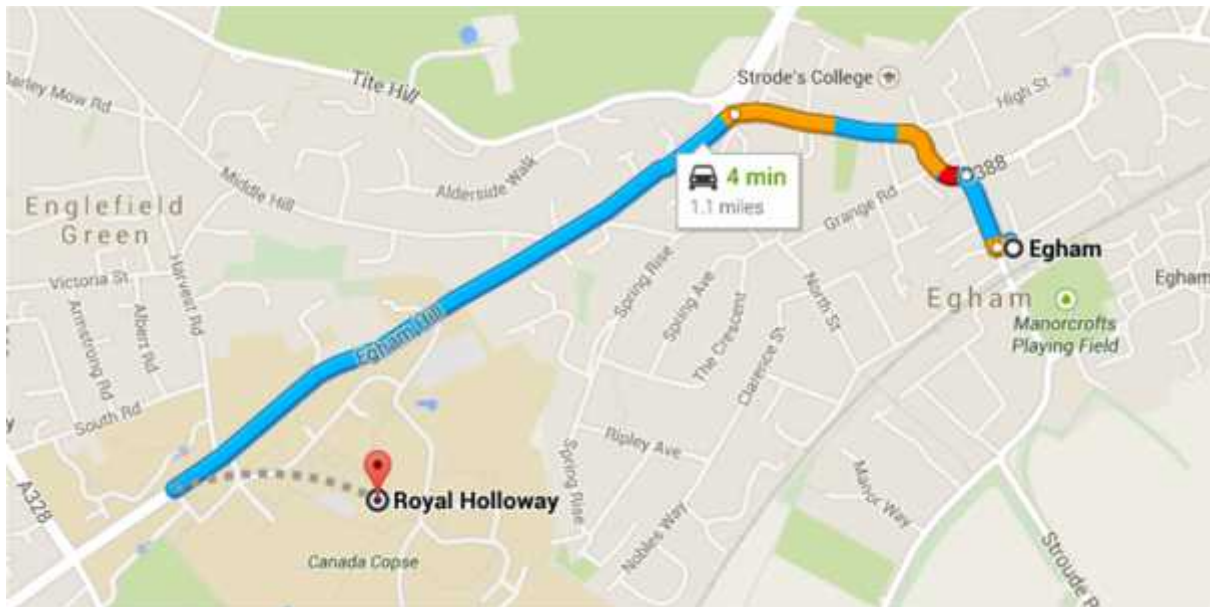

Black cabs from the taxi rank at Heathrow will not accept a fare to Royal Holloway as it is located too close by.

By Rail

- There are four trains an hour from London Waterloo to Egham (40 minutes), Reading to Egham (40 minutes) and Woking to Egham (35 minutes: change at Weybridge). The college is a 20 minute walk from the train station or £5-6.00 taxi ride

On foot from Egham Station



The College is about a mile from the station, which takes about 20 minutes to walk. The easiest route to follow is:

- Turn right out of the station along Station Road and walk about 100 yards to the junction and traffic lights.
- Turn left at the junction and follow the road around to the large roundabout with a petrol station on the left. Walk up Egham Hill (A30) and follow the footpath.
- The main College entrance is on the left immediately after the second footbridge.

Parking

On-site parking will be available in both car parks 4 and 12. Day delegates are encouraged to use car park 12 while delegates staying overnight at the Royal Holloway are advised that car park 4 is more conveniently located. **Please note all vehicles will require a parking pass which can be obtained from the main reception on your arrival.**

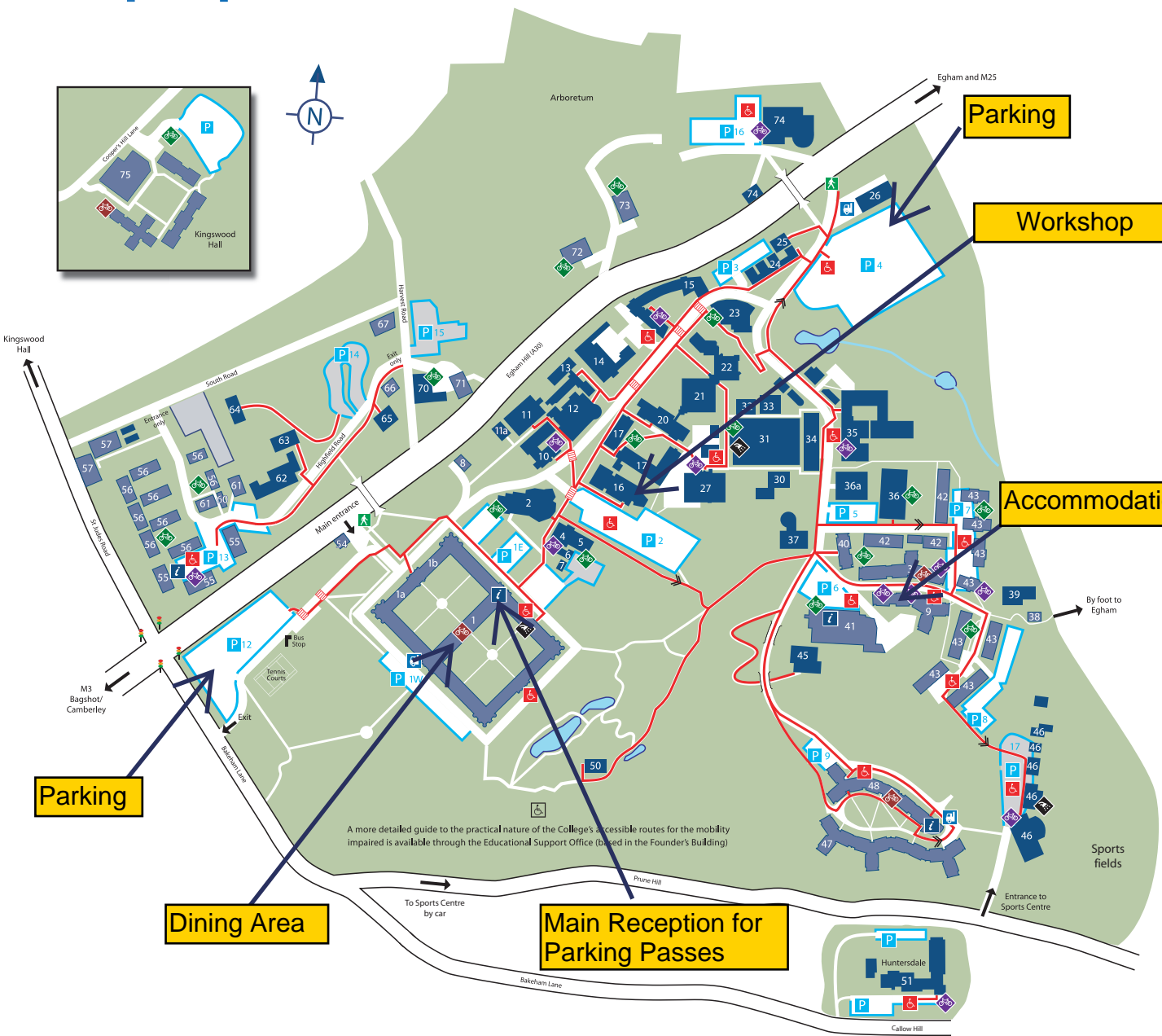
